**Amariyah Bomb Shelter**

**FEBRUARY 13:** Youth and student action, teach-ins and forums on the 12th anniversary of the U.S. bombing of the Amariyah Bomb Shelter. This unprecedented massive assault, calculated to terrorize the Iraqi people during the Gulf War, took place on this day in 1991 and incinerated hundreds of young people, mainly children, and some of their mothers.

**FEBRUARY 14:** New York City teach-in from 9 am to 4 pm on building an anti-war movement that connects the struggle against war on Iraq with the fight for social and economic justice and civil rights at home, Indoor Rally from 7 to 10 pm on linking the struggle against corporate globalization, war, militarism and racism.

**FEBRUARY 15:** Mass mobilization in New York City and around the world. Answer the Call of the European movement for solidarity actions. The A.N.S.W.E.R. Coalition is organizing a full mobilization and support for the action in NYC initiated by UFP.

**FEBRUARY 16 - 20:** Local picket lines, rallies, teach-ins, collection of signatures in the People's Anti-War Referendum ([www.VoteNoWar.org](http://www.VoteNoWar.org))

**FEBRUARY 21:** Students and Youth Action on the anniversary of the assassination of Malcolm X, a Coordinated Day of Resistance -- including student walk-outs from hundreds of high schools and colleges -- and other acts of non-compliance. Malcolm X embodied the spirit of struggle against militarism and the racist establishment. Honor his life and legacy the right way: Resist! Youth and Student A.N.S.W.E.R. will be providing leaflets.
